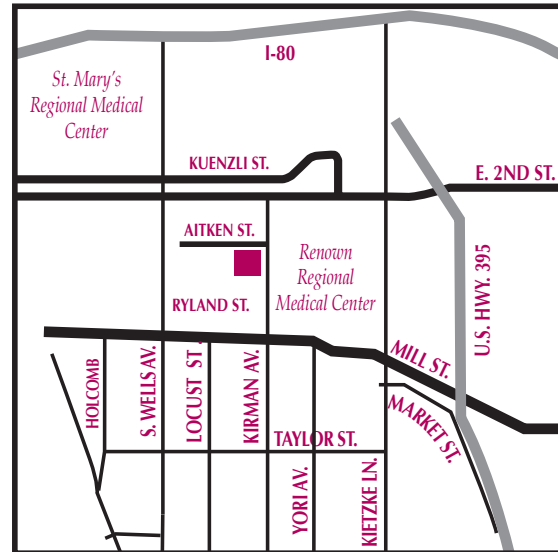

APPOINTMENTS

When calling to schedule an appointment, please inform us of the nature of your injury or problem so that we may allocate an appropriate amount of time for your visit.

To efficiently and effectively evaluate you at the time of your appointment, we will need to have all previously obtained relevant x-rays, reports or other studies you have had available at the time of your visit.

We strive to provide you with the finest in service and care and are acutely aware of how valuable your time is. We make every effort to see you in a timely manner. However, emergencies will occasionally arise which cause a disruption in our schedule. On these occasions, we will attempt to inform you as far in advance as possible, thus allowing you the opportunity to reschedule your appointment as an alternative to waiting. If this occurs and your condition requires that you be seen right away, we will make arrangements for one of our other physicians to see you.

BILLING & INSURANCE

Our physicians are providers for the majority of the health plans available. Our billing office will be happy to submit a claim to your health plan. Please provide us with a copy of your health plan card and any forms needed for submitting your claim.

You are responsible for co-payments, deductibles and non-covered services.

When necessary, our billing office will be glad to accommodate you with arrangements.

AFTER HOUR EMERGENCIES

For those emergencies which arise after our normal business hours, call our regular business number (329-8423) and one of our physicians will be available to assist you.

For non-emergency situations, questions or concerns, please call our office during regular business hours and our office staff and physicians will help you.

PRESCRIPTION REFILLS

We try to process your requests for prescription refills as quickly as possible. When you need a prescription refill, please notify your pharmacist or call our office. Calls received after 2:30 p.m. for routine refills will be handled on the next business day. Please call before 12:00 noon, if possible, to ensure same-day response. During evenings, weekends, and holidays, the doctor on call does not have immediate access to your records. Therefore, routine prescriptions cannot be refilled during this time. Please contact the office during weekdays and before your medication has run out.
